


## RULES 1/2

1. Each player draws 5 solution cards.
2. Pick who judges first. (Come up with a dumb rule for how.)
3. The judge flips over a problem card and asks: "Can anyone fix [read the problem card]?"
4. The other players pick a solution card for that problem, and give it (face-down) to the judge.

## RULES 2/2


5. The judge flips over a solution card. Whoever played it says: "I can fix it!" followed by how they would fix it with their solution card.
6. The judge picks a winning card. Then, the player to the left of the judge becomes the judge.
7. Continue playing until someone has five points.
8. If a player uses ALL 5 of their cards, then they can draw 5 more cards.
