



<div><b>RULES 1/2</b></div> <div><p>1. Each player draws 5 solution cards.</p><p>2. Pick who judges first. (Come up with a dumb rule for how.)</p><p>3. The judge flips over a problem card and asks: "Can anyone fix [read the problem card]?"</p><p>4. The other players pick a solution card for that problem, and give it (face-down) to the judge.</p></div>	<div><b>RULES 2/2</b></div> <div><p>5. The judge flips over a solution card. Whoever played it says: "I can fix it!" followed by how they would fix it with their solution card.</p><p>6. The judge picks a winning card. Then, the player to the left of the judge becomes the judge.</p><p>7. Continue playing until someone has five points.</p><p>8. If a player uses ALL 5 of their cards, then they can draw 5 more cards.</p></div>
